12 Myths about Child Sexual Abuse

- 1. Children lie about being sexually abused.
- 2. Reports of child sexual abuse are exaggerated in the media.
- 3. Children invite sexual abuse by provocative behavior.
- If the child did not want to participate in the sexual abuse, they could stop it.
- Children recant or take back their story of sexual abuse because it never really happened.
- If a child has been sexually abused there will be physical/medical evidence to prove it.
- 7. Children who don't act traumatized must not have been abused.
- Just because there is a little inappropriate touching doesn't mean that any real damage is done.
- 9. Most children are sexually abused by a stranger.
- 10. Men who sexually abuse boys are homosexual
- 11. Boys are able to handle the emotional impact of being sexually abused better than girls.
